Principal's Desk

There has been a considerable amount of concern expressed about the traffic before and after school on Amstutz Road. This topic has come up numerous times in the past years. There is a history of healthy discussions between Allen County Sheriff's Department and the Leo-Cedarville Town Manager. We have also received an adequate amount of feedback from the community.

It is a general consensus that the roads around the school were not designed to handle the high volume of traffic. A proposed entrance and exit from State Road 1 to the south parking lot would alleviate some of the heavy traffic, back-ups on Amstutz and Hosler Road, during school arrival and dismissal times. It is not unusual to have a high volume of traffic around schools at arrival and dismissal times. Leo Jr. Sr. High School's high volume traffic is in the morning between 7:20 a.m. – 7:40 a.m. The afternoon traffic is much more manageable. This is due to the fact that faculty and some students do not leave at dismissal time (2:55 p.m.). This allows for a more gradual release of traffic from the school.

The major concern around a school zone is safety. We are asking our students, parents, and community to use caution and pay special attention to traffic laws around the school zones.

Reminder to drivers when traveling around a school zone:

Please be patient and obey all traffic laws.

Leave home early to allow plenty of time.

Please do not drop off or pick up students on Amstutz Road.

Pick up and drop off students only in pick up and drop off areas; which is in the north lot.

When on Amstutz Road heading south, the right lane heading south near the crosswalk is a turn lane for the day care. The solid white line indicates a no passing zone. It is a traffic violation to use this lane for passing.

The Leo Jr. Sr. High School administration will make some minor changes over the summer to increase safety on the school property. As we are near the end of the school year, please do your part to support school safety.

Respect the school zone! The crossing guard, police officers, low speed limit, yellow flashing light, and legal turns and passes are all created to make the school zone safe for the students. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.

Attention Junior Parents Time for your young adults Meningococcal Booster Vaccine

All incoming seniors need to have their meningococcal booster prior to the start of their senior year.

Feel free to vaccinate early prior to warm and fun weather and bring documentation to the School Clinic.

- Meningitis is caused by bacteria that can be spread through the exchange of respiratory and throat secretions (e.g. saliva or mucus). Sharing drinks, kissing, close contact. Commonly spread amongst young adults on campus.
