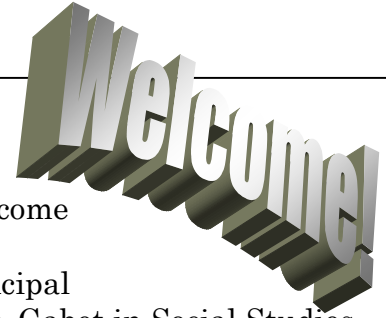

EACS will use a new registration process this year. Attending registration is mandatory, as you need to pick up your course schedules with homeroom and locker information as well as any changes that may have occurred.

IMPORTANT!

Proof of residency* and a photo ID will be required from EVERYONE (not just new enrollments) to complete the registration process. Please bring these items with you to registration. Students must be registered by the legal guardian/parent.

Registration will take place on **August 9th** from 3:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m. and **August 10th** from 8:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. in the auditoria. At registration you may purchase athletic passes, 2011 yearbooks, PTSA membership, parking permits, and pay class dues. Please enter the main south entrance and registration will be in the auditoria. You may pay with one check, payable to Leo High School (see sample form enclosed for cost calculation).

***Proof of Residency – any utility bill, legal document, or housing/rental agreement that shows both the student’s legal guardian’s name and address.**
