DUAL CREDIT VS. ADVANCED PLACEMENT LEO HIGH SCHOOL COURSE OPTIONS

The Decision

Dual Credit or Advanced Placement—which one is right for you?

Dual Credit

College-level rigor
Starts permanent college transcript
Significantly lower cost than on-campus tuition
Up to 6 credits per year, with passing grade
Academic Honors Diploma: *(except those listed with *)*
6 credits needed (3-4 per semester)
Accepted by most out of state & private institutions
If outside Indiana Core Transfer Library, may be counted

Advanced Placement

College-level rigor
Does not start permanent college transcript
Course is free (test fee up to \$90.00)
Up to 3 credits per year, only if AP test is passed
Academic Honors Diploma:
4 credits needed (1 per semester)
Better chance of being accepted at highest universities



Internships

- I.C.E. – 12th grade
 - Application Required
 - Paid out-of-school internship (12th grade)
 - Up to 4 periods per day/semester
 - One-year commitment
 - Must be in career area of interest
- Out-of-School Internships – (11th & 12th)
 - Application Required
 - Unpaid
 - 2-3 periods per day/semester



Anthnis Career Center

Grades 11-12

- Application Required
- Technical/Career Center
- 4 periods out per day/semester
- Full year commitment
- Must provide your own transportation
- Some programs require criminal history checks, uniforms, and equipment
