**The University of Cincinnati** has established an Indiana/Ohio Reciprocity Agreement, which will allow students living in Allen, Adams, DeKalb, Steuben, Noble, or Wells County to attend at Ohio-resident tuition rates. This is an annual savings of approximately \$14,500. (The offer excludes students enrolling in the nursing program or college of pharmacy's doctor of pharmacy program.) After being accepted to U of C, students must submit the required documentation to receive in-state tuition. SAT/ACT test scores must be sent directly from the testing agencies to U of C.
