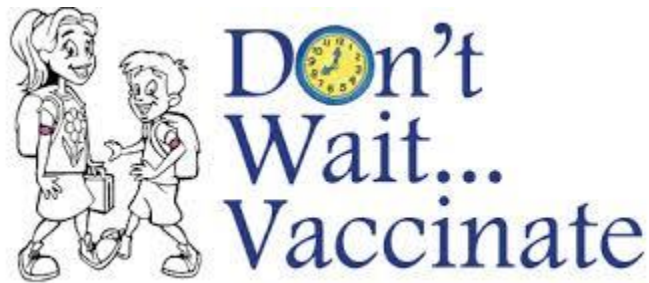


It's time for your young adult's Meningococcal Booster Vaccine



All incoming seniors need to have their meningococcal booster (MCV4) prior to the start of their senior year (the second dose is *not* required for students who received dose 1 of MCV4 on or after their 16th birthday). Bring documentation of shot given to the School Clinic.

- Meningitis is caused by bacteria that can be spread through the exchange of respiratory and throat secretions (e.g. saliva or mucus), sharing drinks, kissing, close contact. Commonly spread amongst young adults on campus.
